1. World Care has designated two GVR centers as donation drop off locations. PLEASE SHOP FROM THE LIST. Storing and transporting clothing, housewares, toys, and the like create a hardship for the crisis personnel who are working fast to respond to the highest priorities first.

The GVR Foundation is ready to receive these donations immediately, and will provide donors with receipts acknowledging their tax deductible contribution. The GVR Foundation will then donate the materials to World Care, which dispatched its first 3500lb shipment out of Tucson last night.

2. The **Greater Green Valley Community Foundation** and **Green Valley Council** have agreed to collaborate with this project. A special thanks to **AZ Rental Center, U-Haul** of Green Valley for donating boxes for our collection efforts. Other local non-profits are expected to join in the effort.
